MOORE MEMORIAL TROPHY

The *Moore Memorial Trophy Competition* was started in 1973 as a memorial to Colonel L Moore who was President for many years and did so much for our County Association

The competition is open to all members of clubs who affiliate to HSBRPA.

As the trophies are purchased annually (they are not challenge trophies) with the interest money from the Moore Memorial Fund.

The competition for the Prone Rifle Section is as follows:

	Class D	91.49 and below

Four rounds of the Winter Postal Rifle League, with two reserve numbers, are nominated at the beginning of the season by an independent person, and these cards comprise the competition, so no extra ammunition or cards are needed for people who fire in the Winter Rifle League. The two reserve numbers are only used in case of a tie.

Those persons not shooting in the Winter Rifle League, yet wishing to enter, should be listed below with a current average confirmed by their Club Secretary (calculated from the best ten of the last twelve NSRA official match cards). Cards will be sent to be fired in given match periods.

These cards, when fired must be returned to the Secretary for adjudication.

HAMPSHIRE SMALL-BORE RIFLE AND PISTOL ASSOCIATION COUNTY SMALLBORE RIFLE WINTER LEAGUE

Entries are invited for the County Rifle Winter League

AWARDS

Awards will be made in accordance with Rule 11 of the League Rules.

CONDITIONS

1. Teams will be placed in a division according to averages submitted. All individual averages attained in the County League last season must be entered on the entry forms. If a person did not shoot in this league then the average of the best 10 of the last 12 match cards or recorded scores must be given. The County Committee reserves the right to adjust any average found to be inaccurately submitted.
2. Teams will consist of five competitors.
3. The matches may be fired on 15, 20 or 25 yards ranges, under County League conditions. Stickers will be supplied by the County Association, these stickers **MUST BE STUCK ON THE FRONT OF EACH MATCH CARD BEFORE THE LEAGUE COMMENCES.**
4. Ten shots only will be fired at the match card but the competitor may return to the sighter at any time if he/she so wishes.
5. Where a club enters more than one team the best available members must be placed in the 'A' team, the next best in the 'B' team and so on. Members of all teams must be registered at the time of entry. Such registrations may be altered after entry but before the League has been formed. A competitor must shoot in the team for which he/she is registered but subject to changes as authorised by the County League Rules.
6. Cards must be despatched to the Divisional Adjudicators as soon as possible after the completion of the shoot, but in any case, **must** reach the adjudicator by the Saturday morning following the last day of shooting. Cards must be shot in **round order** and may be fired in advance as instructed on the stickers. In view of increasing difficulties in the postal system it is advisable to keep well in advance with all shooting and send more than two sets at a time. This will also save a little on postage costs

Note - THE GREAT IMPORTANCE OF CORRECT WITNESSING IS AGAIN EMPHASISED

The duties and qualifications of witnesses are laid down in NSRA Rules. Every card in the County Competition **MUST** be signed by the competitor, then signed and correctly dated by the witness immediately after the card has been shot. Rubber stamps used for signatures or for dating the cards will lead to disqualification. If any card is not signed, witnessed and dated correctly the card **WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**

Any further information may be supplied on application to the Hon. General Secretary. County League Rules should be made available to all members of clubs, not just the Club Secretary.

TEAM HANDICAP COMPETITION FOR THE ELIZABETHAN TROPHY

AWARDS

Winners will receive the **Challenge Trophy** and six plaques. Runners-up will receive six plaques.

1. Open to teams of 6 from any affiliated club. Any number of teams may be entered but NO competitor may shoot for more than one team throughout the competition. Stickers will be issued by the organiser up to and including the quarter-final round.
2. The competition will be conducted as a postal knockout, teams being drawn in pairs, the winning team being entitled to compete in the next round. 10 shots per firer. This will apply up to and including the semi-final. The final will be fired on the home range of the finalists but will be a 20 shot per person on each of 2 cards. The match will be fired as a team within a time limit of two hours.
3. When making entries, Club Secretaries must fill in the entry form giving names of their members who will shoot in each team, together with the starts required; every competitor MUST have a start. Reserves may be brought in but may only shoot for one team throughout the competition. Should a member of the originally nominated team not be available, the reserve who takes his/her place MUST accept the registered start of the number for whom he/she is substitute.
4. Cards will be adjudicated by the Organiser, who in turn must receive any alterations of handicaps when the cards for the previous round are sent in, stating the new handicap required.
5. When the cards are adjudicated, to the start of each competitor will be added the gun score. Should the total exceed 100, two points will be deducted from the total for each point in excess of 100.

6. If a competitor places two shots on one diagram, or otherwise misplaces a shot, the NSRA rule will apply.
7. Cards must be signed, witnessed and dated immediately after the cards have been shot. They must not be gauged or interfered with, deviation from these rules will lead to disqualification.
8. All cards must be sent without delay to the organiser after they have been completed.
9. All shooting will be governed by the rules of the NSRA and the Hampshire Small-Bore Rifle and Pistol Association.

AWARDS

The *David Pragnell Trophy* will be awarded to the winning pair, plus two souvenirs. The remaining three pairs shooting in the final will also receive souvenirs.

CONDITIONS

1. The competition is open to any pair, not necessarily club pairs, whose combined average does not exceed 192, and each round will be two cards per person.
2. Submitted averages must be taken from the previous season, preferably the Hampshire Postal League. If this is not possible, then another average may be submitted but must be confirmed by a recognised official.
3. Each round will be fired in groups of four pairs, with the best two pairs going through to the next round.
4. The last four pairs in the competition will fire shoulder-to-shoulder.
5. Cards may be shot on receipt of the stickers, which must be affixed to the front of the cards before shooting commences. Cards must be returned to the adjudicator by the indicated date.
6. Ties will be decided by the use of graduated gauges.
7. Any challenge will be accepted before the following round commences on receipt of the usual challenge fee as in the Hampshire Postal League, which will be returnable if the challenge is upheld.

AWARDS

The winner of the competition will be awarded the *Trophyman Salver* and souvenir, further prizes will be awarded to all who shoot in the Final Stage.

CONDITIONS

1. Open to Associate Members and members of clubs affiliated to the Hampshire Small-Bore Rifle and Pistol Association.
2. When making entries, Hon. Secretaries must fill in the entry form giving names of their members together with the starts required. The minimum start allowed is five and the start is for each string of ten shots. For example, if a person asks for a start of six, he must try to drop six points on each set of ten shots, not six points overall. The start must be indicated in the appropriate column.
3. The competition will be run in three stages, highest 20 scores and equal lowest scores from first round to go through to the second round and highest 12 competitors from the second round go into the Final Stage.
4. The Final Stage will be shot shoulder-to-shoulder, the other stages will be conducted as a postal shoot.
5. Number of shots - 20 per competitor, per stage.
6. Time allowed - to be shot within one hour.
7. Stickers will be issued and must be affixed to the front of each match card before shooting commences.
8. If a competitor fires an excess number of shots on any diagram there will be a penalty of two points. Ten scoring shots must be placed on the appropriate aiming marks. If shots miss the scoring area the competitor must place further scoring shots on the appropriate aiming marks, with a penalty of two points for each shot in excess of ten. The penalty points will be deducted after the handicap has been taken into consideration.
9. Cards must be signed, witnessed and dated immediately after the shoot has taken place.
10. If there are ties to move forward from one stage to the next, graduated gauges will be used.

TARGETS

Targets must be the same as those being used in the various competitions organised by the Country Association during the winter season.

STAGES

Details of all stages will be circulated by the organiser. For the postal stages, all cards must be returned to the organiser not later than the Saturday following the closing date for each stage.

CONDITIONS

Open to all Life, Annual, Associate and Shooting Members of the NSRA who are affiliated to Hampshire.

Competitors must be resident in the County they represent.

Range 15, 20, 25 yard or 25m, proportionate British NSRA BM/1989 Series Match Cards.

In each of the first three stages, competitors will fire 40 shots as follows:

- (a) Twenty shots deliberate, 10 each at two 10-bull match cards.
- (b) Twenty shots time-limit, 10 each at two 10-bull cards, 90 seconds allowed for each card. (A Competitor will load and fire on the signal to 'commence' and may not fire after the signal to 'cease'. Time will be reckoned from the signal to 'commence'.)

Each competitor must shoot their 40 shots (20 Deliberate and 20 Time Limit) within a single day. Stickers will be supplied by the county and will be clearly marked Deliberate or Time Limit.

THE FIRST STAGE

To be shot in November

THE SECOND STAGE

To be shot during the period 31st December and 27th January.

THE THIRD STAGE - (COUNTY STAGE)

To be shot during the period 28th February and 27th March inclusive.

Hampshire will supply NSRA official stickers for the 3rd Stage to the six leading scorers in the Second Stage, and the shot targets sent in bulk to:-

FINAL STAGE OF THE QUEEN ALEXANDRA CUP

The Match will be shot on the first Saturday of the Bisley Rifle Meeting

Each competitor will fire 2 x 10 rounds deliberate and 2 x 10 rounds time limit on NSRA 25 **metre** BM/89 targets plus one minute firing on skirmisher targets. On this card a third hit on any diagram will not be counted unless there are at least two hits in each of the target areas.

All shooting will be on 10 bull targets except skirmisher and changed after each set of 10 shots.

INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION

The leading scorer from each County in the County Stage of the competition will qualify to take part in the Final of the Individual Competition which will take place under the same conditions at the same time as the County Teams Final at Bisley. COMP 3 An individual competition restricted to shooters with an SH2 dispensation to shoot from a sitting position and using a Belgian Rest to support the rifle.

The Association recognises that the NSRA can be very slow in processing applications for dispensations. Consequently, SH1/2 status for a shooter will be assumed if it is confirmed by the club that application has been made. 'Belgian Rests' used by shooters with a SH2 dispensation must conform to these same IPC regulations. No other form of rest is permitted.
