AFFILIATION

Air and Small-bore rifle and pistol clubs affiliated to the NSRA are welcome to affiliate to HSBRPA for the purpose of participating in summer competitions organised by the Association.

If a club has not yet affiliated to HSBRPA then affiliation fees are due to be paid to enter our summer competition

HAMPSHIRE SMALL-BORE RIFLE AND PISTOL ASSOCIATION SUMMER INDIVIDUAL PISTOL LEAGUE 20 yds

AWARDS

Winners of each division will receive medals, further individual medals according to entry.

CONDITIONS

1. Competitors will be placed in divisions according to averages submitted. The average of the best 10 of the last 12 match cards or recorded scores must be entered on the entry form.
2. Further rules of this competition will be sent to each club by the Air Weapons Stats. Officer

SUMMER BENCHREST LEAGUE

AWARDS

Winners of each division will receive medals, further individual medals according to entry.

CONDITIONS

There are two competitions:

- Team Competitions, 4 shooters per team (competitor can only shoot for 1 team)
- Individual competition (can be shot concurrently with the team comp).

Competitors will be put into Divisions according to their current averages, for persons new to this competition the averages of 6 qualifying cards must be submitted.

LIGHTWEIGHT SPORTS RIFLE LEAGUES

Entries are invited for Hampshire's Summer 2019 lightweight sporting rifle postal competition.

Clubs wishing to enter should complete *one or other* of the entry form(s) available via download from <http://www.hsbrpa.org.uk/gdownloads/gindex.php> or email from havant.rpclsr@virginmedia.com

Either word processor or spreadsheet format is acceptable.

The forms **must be completed electronically** in order to assist the competition secretary in collating entry information. Scans of handwritten forms or PDF versions of the form will be returned!

Clubs are advised that payment must be made via bank credit transfer, details on the entry form. Please do not forget to provide a reference that identifies your club as the payee (see form).

There are three types of competition:

- The team competition, four shooters per team, any number of teams may be entered
- The individual competition, which can be shot concurrently with the team competition.
- A handicap competition, free to enter for all those who shot in the previous season

Each consists of 10 rounds, 20 shots per round at 20 yards on the NSRA PL14/06-18 or PL14-18 target, 5 shots per target. Last dates for shooting each round are at roughly two week intervals, though cards may be shot at any date prior to the shoot-by date. The round 1 date should be around end-April.

AWARDS

Medals are awarded to the winning team and the top individual in each division.

Further individual medals may be awarded according to entry. E.g. best improver based on handicap.

PRONE SMALLBORE RIFLE SUMMER LEAGUE

AWARDS

Winners of each division will receive medals, further individual medals according to entry.

CONDITIONS

This is an indoor prone rifle league with self scoring.

There are team and individual competitions, with teams requiring four competitors. The team and individual competitions may be shot concurrently.

Both the team and individual competitions will comprise 10 cards, 1 card due every two weeks with the first due in early May. The competition is deliberately spread out to account for summer holidays.

This competition is open to all Hampshire Association club members

This is a free to enter competition which is run concurrently with competition 11 of the Bisley Rifle Championships in August.

Persons who wish to register their interest in being considered for this competition should email their Name, Club and Bisley competitor number to dave-salver@hsbrpa.org.uk or add their Name, Club and Bisley competitor number to a form that will be available in the HSBRPA tent on Century Range during the weekend aggregate.

Awards

The Dave Nevatte salver and a gold medal will be awarded to the competitor who finishes highest across all classes (ties will be decided by 100yrd aggregate class position)

A silver medal will be awarded to the 2nd place competitor

A bronze medal will be awarded to the 3rd place competitor
